

**RESOLUTION No. 08-14-24.1**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ELK RIVER, CLEARWATER COUNTY, IDAHO  
ADOPTING CITY OF ELK RIVER'S FEE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk River has reviewed all fees charged for services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk River has determined that periodic revisions may be necessary.

WHEREAS, the City has fees for services already established; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk River has determined that the fee schedule be amended to reflect the reasonable cost of providing the services; and

WHEREAS, after public hearing on August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024, has been held prior to the adoption of this resolution, in accordance with Idaho Code Section 63-1311A, regarding new increased city fees, it is deemed by the city council to be in the best interests of the City of Elk River and the citizens thereof that the fee schedule be amended to included the new and increased fees which were addressed in the public hearing.

NOW THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Elk River, Idaho that the following fee schedule, which reflects the new and amended fees; and the existing fees that have not been amended, be adopted effective the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2024:

- ❖ Anything over 2,000 gallons is an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons.
- ❖ A deposit of \$150 is required for all new accounts for water-sewer-garbage service for rentals. This will be refunded at the end of residency after all bills for water-sewer-garbage are paid in full. This amount is based on a monthly average for city utilities and

is subject to change. Property owners who sign an agreement with the City, there is no deposit required from renters.

- ❖ Accounts not paid in full by the last billing day of the month shall be assessed a \$15.00 delinquent fee.
- ❖ \$40.00 charge to turn water on and a \$40.00 charge for water being turned off when the City is forced to do so due to a delinquent account.
- ❖ Disconnection of services per request of property owner: \$200.00 per service.
- ❖ No charge to turn water on and no charge for water being turned off per request from property owner.
- ❖ Any water service patron needing emergency water shut off due to leaks, broken pipes or water heaters, will be billed for labor and equipment costs. Those emergency shut offs that occur after regular business hours (after 3:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday), over weekends, or on holidays will be billed at time and a half for labor in addition to equipment costs (First Effective 2-14-07).



Commercial – restaurants, taverns, food stores, lodging	Equivalent of 3 – 40 pound bags per week	\$29.07 per month
Commercial with residence	Equivalent of 5 – 40 pound bags per week	\$31.55 per month

- ❖ \$1.27 for each additional bag over allowances

This revised fee schedule shall be effective beginning October 1, 2024 unless authorized date is otherwise indicated in the Resolution and shall remain in force until revised by subsequent Resolutions of the City of Elk River City Council
